- Absences from periods 5-6 on the day of your exam will not be cleared by the AP Coordinator or your AP Teacher.

## Afternoon Exams:

- You are expected to attend periods 1-3 on the day of your exam.
- Absences from periods 1-3 on the day of your exam will not be cleared by the AP Coordinator or your AP Teacher.
- Attend 1<sup>st</sup> Lunch.
- Report to your testing location at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> lunch (11:40 on a regular day, 11:50 on a late-start day). Your proctor will meet you and begin the sign-in process at this time.
- Arrive on time!
- You will be cleared from periods 4-6.
- While it is impossible to predict the EXACT end time of each afternoon exam session, please note that it will be well past the end of the regular school day and arrange for transportation accordingly.

## AP Student Contract:

I have been informed of the following information regarding AP Exams, and I agree to: *(Please initial next to each statement)*

\_\_\_\_\_ Not bring bags, backpacks, books or other materials into the test area.  
*A designated area of each testing room will be established for personal items. Students will not be allowed to access these items at any time during the exam administration, not even during breaks.*

\_\_\_\_\_ Not bring cell phones, headphones, I-pods, or any other electronic storage or media devices into the test area.  
*Students with a cell phone or electronic device on the exam day will be required to deactivate the device and place it in a clearly labeled Ziplock bag. Students will not have access to these items at any time during the exam administration. Use of any electronic or communication device during testing or during a break will result in dismissal from the exam and cancellation of the exam scores.*

\_\_\_\_\_ Place snacks in a Ziplock bag with your name on the front.  
*Snacks will be placed in a box as you enter the testing room, You will get your snacks back at the break.*

\_\_\_\_\_ Be prepared for temperature fluctuations in the exam room, dress in layers and/or bring a sweater or sweatshirt.

\_\_\_\_\_ Bring several sharpened #2 pencils

\_\_\_\_\_ Bring pens with black or dark blue ink

\_\_\_\_\_ Bring only AP approved calculators, if allowed for your exam
