Summary of the Most Recent Site Inspection:

The district takes great efforts to ensure that all schools are clean, safe, and functional. To assist in this effort, the district uses a facility survey instrument developed by the State of California Office of Public School Construction. The results of this survey are available at the school office or at the district office.

The latest site inspection was held on October 8, 2009. Based on the field observations the following was found.

Repairs Needed:

- Stained and missing tiles in several rooms.
- Hand dryers not working; light bulbs out.
- Several sinks not working; several drinking fountains not working properly; one boys RR very dirty and has 15 used urinals stored there, also 1 urinal leaking on the floor.
- Bad valve leak at gate.
