NCLB Public School Choice and Supplemental Educational Services (SES)**

Public School Choice

Program Improvement schools offer parents/guardians of eligible students *Public School Choice*, which is the option of transferring to an available school in the district that has not been identified as a Program Improvement school. Before considering this option, we encourage you to visit your child's school to learn about the various supportive programs and services.

If you wish to take advantage of *Public School Choice*, transportation may be provided to the non-PI school for as long as the home school continues to be identified as a PI school. If the home school exits PI by making AYP for two consecutive years, your child can remain at the chosen school; however, transportation will no longer be provided by the district. If the demand for choice exceeds available funds, priority will be given to lowest achieving, low-income students.

The NCLB School Choice application is available at the school and district office. Transfer requests received will be reviewed and processed on a first come, first served basis. Applicants will be individually notified of eligibility and transfer information. Below are the school choice options available to you.

Supplemental Educational Services

Under the *No Child Left Behind Act*, Supplemental Educational Services (SES) are FREE tutoring Services available from a provider (a state-approved private organization, company, or agency) to help your child improve his/her language arts or math skills.

Eligibility

If your child qualifies for the *Free/Reduced Price Lunch Program* and is enrolled at a Year 2 or above Program Improvement (PI) school, he/she may qualify for free SES tutoring. If funds are insufficient to provide SES to all eligible students, students will be prioritized according to academic need based on the students' academic achievement levels on statewide achievement tests. Current schools eligible for SES are Foothill, La Granada, Myra Linn, Rosemary Kennedy and Valley View.

Your Choice

If you decide to enroll your child in SES, review the summary of state-approved providers on the SES Provider List and select two providers. List these providers in order of preference on your child's application in the space provided.

How to Enroll

If you decide to enroll your child in the SES program, you must complete a Supplemental Educational Services application which is available in your child's school office and on the district's website. Return the completed application to the school office. You must complete a separate application for each child attending the school. The district maintains an open window for enrollment beginning September 1, 2011.

Notification

If your child is selected for SES you will receive a letter from the district. You will then be contacted by the provider to arrange a schedule of services. If your child is not selected, you will be advised as soon as possible by the district office.

Transportation

Transportation to and from the chosen provider is generally the responsible of the parent. The district will NOT provide transportation. Parents will need to make plans to get their children to and from tutoring sessions. Many providers provide tutoring in the child's home. See list of providers approved to serve eligible students in eligible schools in the Alvord Unified School District, provider locations for services, and those providers able to serve students with disabilities and English learners.
